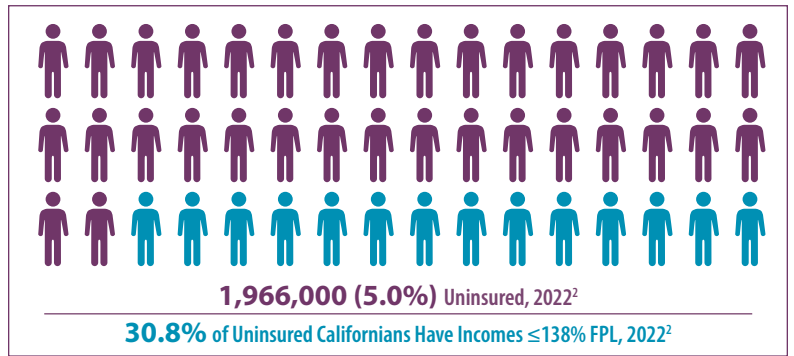
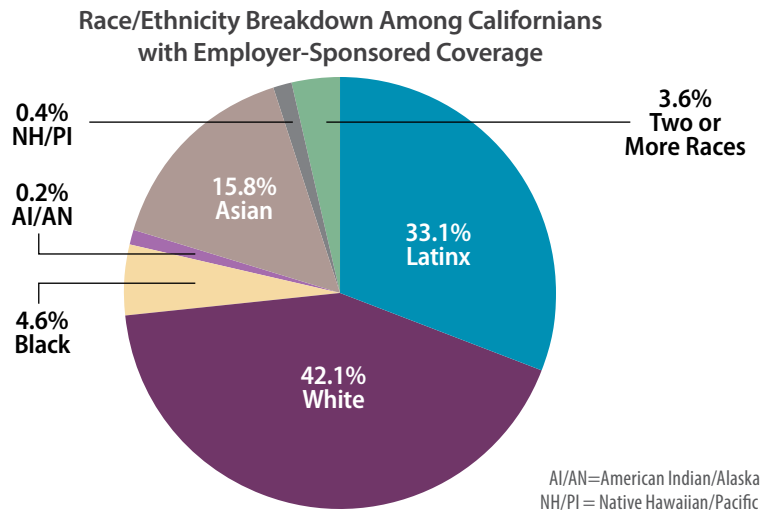
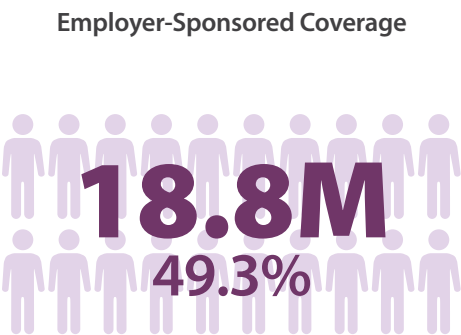


FIGURE 2. Employer-Sponsored Coverage, 2022²

FIGURE 3. Percent of California Population Enrolled in Covered California, March 2024³

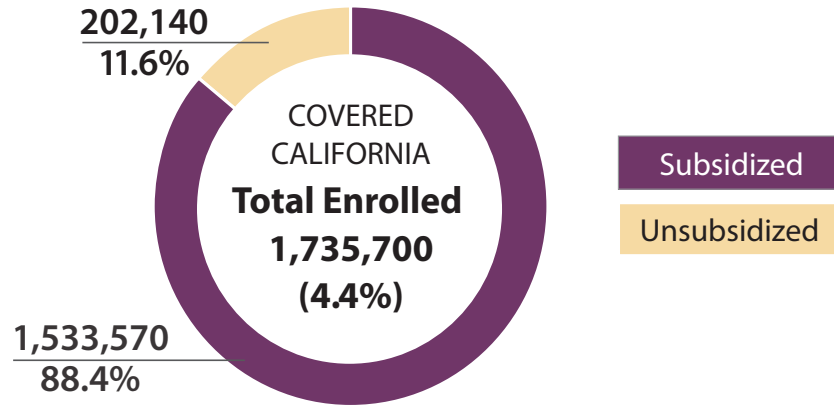


FIGURE 4. Covered California Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, March 2024³

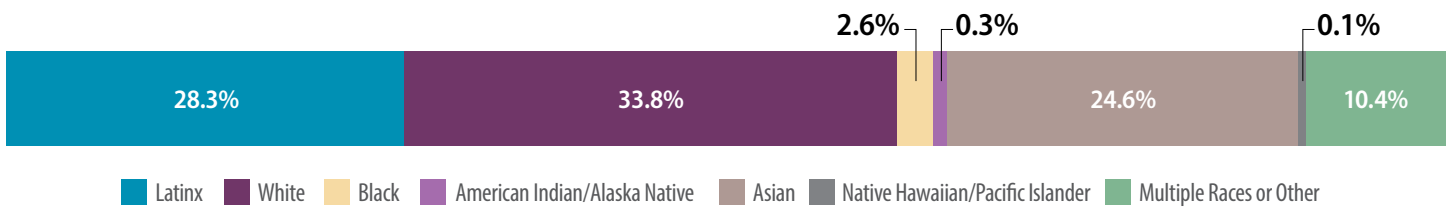
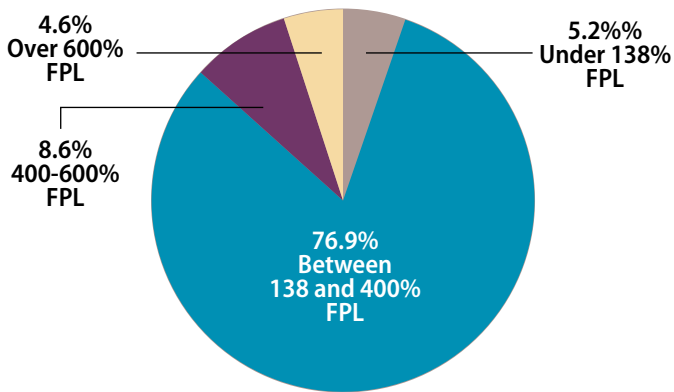


FIGURE 5. Covered California Enrollment by FPL, March 2024³

FIGURE 8. Medi-Cal Enrollment, by Race/Ethnicity, June 2024⁶

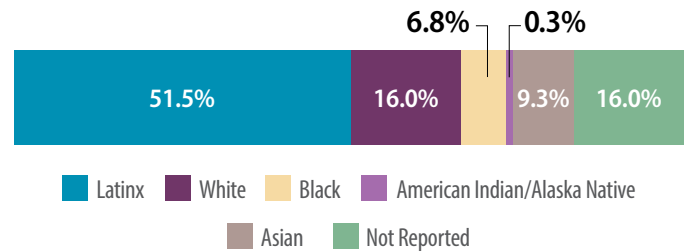


FIGURE 9. Medi-Cal Enrollment by Managed Care and Fee-for-Service (FFS), June 2024⁷

FIGURE 11. Percentage of Community Supports Population by Race/Ethnicity⁹

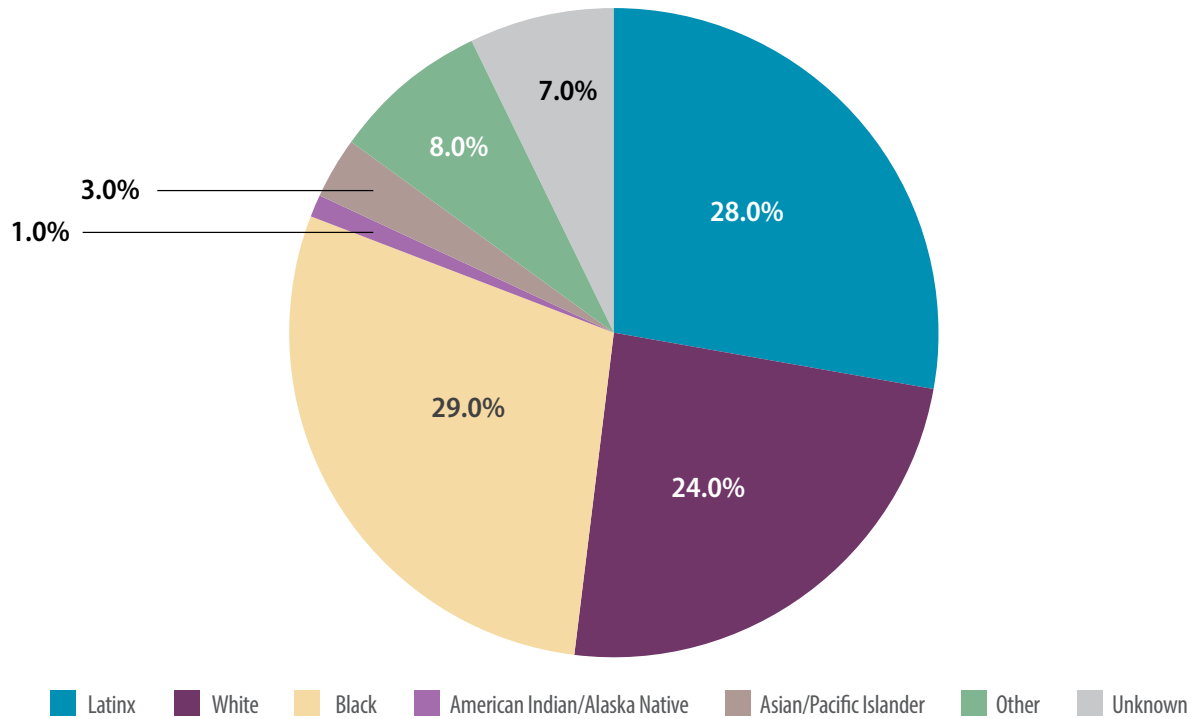
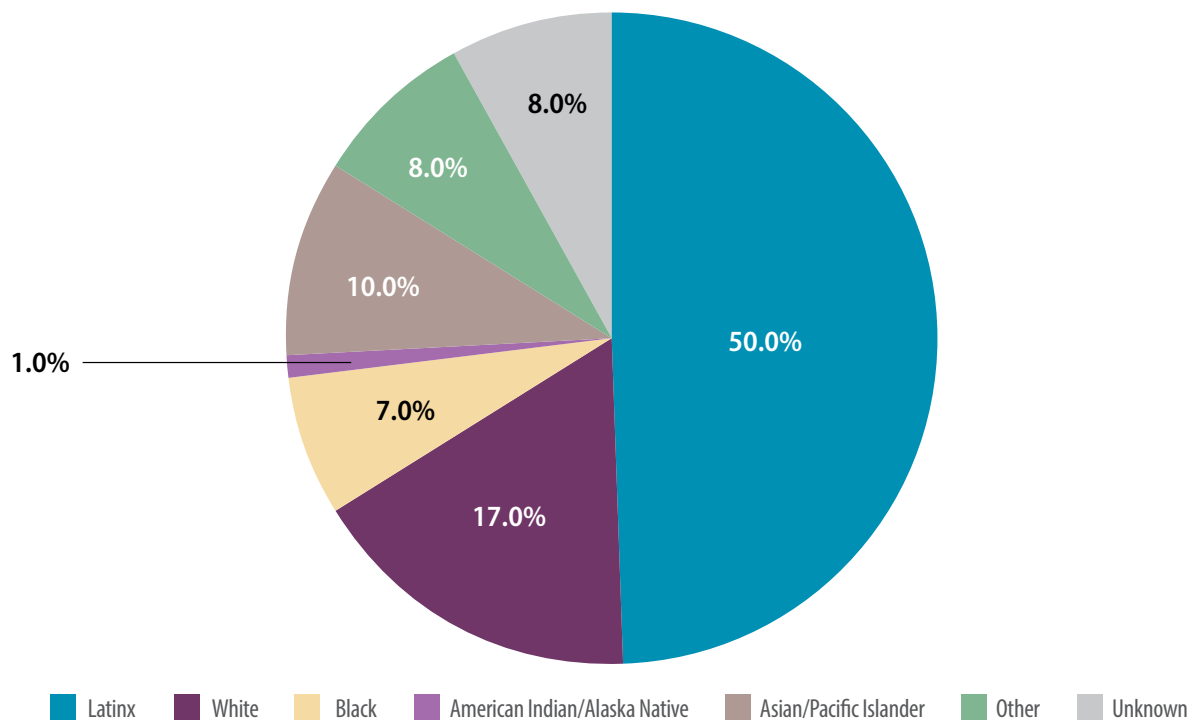


FIGURE 12. Percentage of MCP Population by Race/Ethnicity⁹





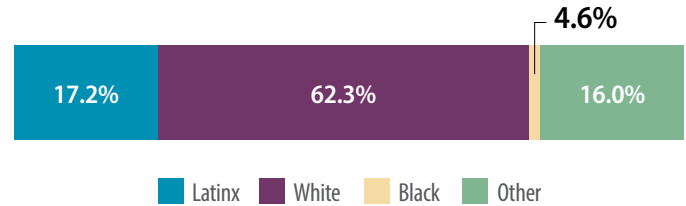
