


#### FIGURE 2. Employer-Sponsored Coverage, 2022<sup>2</sup>

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

Race/Ethnicity Breakdown Among Californians with Employer-Sponsored Coverage






#### FIGURE 3. Percent of California Population Enrolled in Covered California, March 2024<sup>3</sup>





#### FIGURE 5. Covered California Enrollment by FPL, March 2024<sup>3</sup>




#### FIGURE 6. Covered California Enrollment by Health Plan, March 2024<sup>3</sup>




